Follow your machine's instructions to load the SVG or PNG files into the software you use with your electronic cutting machine and craft away! We recommend using the SVG version, but if you are unable to use the SVG, your software may allow you to use the PNG version instead.

These cut files were designed to coordinate with one of our photopolymer stamp sets, and were designed to create a cut just a little bit larger than your stamp. We recommend that you make your first cut out of scrap paper just to make sure that you like the amount of margin we selected. If it isn't quite right, use your software to adjust the size of the file so that it is just the amount of space you want!



To make things convenient, SVG and PNG versions of the same file will always be in the same folder.
